Chocloate

causes vomiting,
hyperactivity,
tremors, seizures,
heart problems



Grapes & Raisins

can cause sudden
kidney failure in dogs
no known safe
ingestion amount



Onions, Garlic, Leeks & Chives

damages red blood
cells, leading to anemia



Xylitol

(sugar-free gum, candy,
peanut butter) causes
low blood sugar and
liver failure in dogs



Alcohol & Raw Dough

causes severe illness,
low blood sugar and
liver failure in dogs



Caffeine

(coffee, tea, energy
drinks) causes
restlessness, tremors,
seizures



Macadamia Nuts

causes weakness,
vomiting, tremors (dogs)



Avocado

causes vomiting and
diarrhea (very toxic to
birds & rabbits)



Salt

can lead to tremors,
seizures, coma



Fatty Foods & Cooked Bones

can cause pancreatitis,
GI obstruction, or injury

toxic plants for dogs and cats



Asiatic Lilies

cause kidney failure and can be fatal in cats



Sago Palm

causes severe liver failure



Aloe Vera

causes vomiting, diarrhea, lethargy



Dieffenbachia (Dumb Cane)

causes mouth irritation, drooling, vomiting



Philodendron / Pothos / Monstera

cause mouth irritation, drooling, vomiting



Peace Lily

causes drooling, vomiting, swallowing difficulty



Oleander

causes heart problems, can be fatal



Azaleas & Rhododendrons

cause vomiting, diarrhea, heart issues



Tulip & Daffodil Bulbs

cause vomiting, drooling, abdominal pain



Castor Bean

very toxic; causes vomiting, shock, death
